Materials Needed


- Several sheets of blank copy paper
- A black sharpie or black marker medium to thin thickness
- Colored pencils/crayons and markers
- Circular objects to use to draw a circle on paper (various sizes)
- Ruler...optional
- Additional black markers of varied thickness...optional

Warm Up: Playing With Patterns

- Take one sheet of blank paper and fold in half each direction twice to create 16 sections.
- Pick a section to fill with parallel straight horizontal lines
- In another section, draw parallel vertical lines.
- In another area use parallel lines in two different directions Next try squiggly lines
- Try creating a pattern of dots or circles.
- Next try a specific pattern, like a daisy or stars.
- In each section focus on filling the entire section with your chosen pattern and create 16 different patterns





Warm Up – Playing with Patterns



Beginning your Zen Circle Design


- Starting with a fresh sheet of paper, use a circular template or plate to draw a large circle.
- Use at least 2-3 lines through the circle. They can be straight, curvy or looping.






Start adding patterns from your warm-up designs, be sure to entirely fill in the space created by your lines. If you have a pattern you really like you can use it again

Keep adding different patterns...take your time!



When every space is filled with patterns you are ready to add color.


- Colored pencils

- Crayons




Want to do a different one? Here are some ideas.


- Instead of a circle trace around your hands

Begin your Zen drawing with 5 dots....and then had lines that start at the dot and end on the edge of the paper...use lots of lines from each dot






Sample of 5 dots Zen
