Blended First Aid/CPR/AED * Balboa * Date: Mon Nov 01, 6:30 PM - 8:30 PM PDT

Be prepared to help in an emergency! Join our ASHI-certified course and meet the Girl Scout requirement for first aiders. The blended course features an at-home online learning session, followed by a skills session led by Girl Scout staff.

Register for this date as your in-person session. You must complete the online session in advance. Access to the online session will be provided within two business days of registration.

The skills session will be held outdoors with appropriate COVID precautions. Details provided when you register. This course covers your role as a Girl Scout first aider and how to care for many illnesses and injuries. Successful learners will receive training and certification in infant, child, and adult care. No prior medical training is required.

New Troops: FIRST 30 DAYS AFTER TROOP LAUNCH:

Ensure that an adult member of your troop is trained in first aid. See sdgirlscouts.org/training to learn about options.

IN THE FIRST 3 MONTHS AFTER YOUR TROOP HAS LAUNCHED

Host your first parent meeting. Use the parent meeting packet to guide you.

Plan your first troop meeting on the Volunteer Toolkit.

Log into My GS/VTK at sdgirlscouts.org. Choose My GS to update your troop meeting info or check your troop roster.

Attend your first service unit meeting and take your co-leader along for the ride.

Hold your first-ever Girl Scout troop meeting!

Open your Girl Scout bank account when you have \$50 in troop funds or within 60 days of starting the troop. Make sure you have a registered, background checked volunteer in the Troop Treasurer role and that they have completed the Troop Treasurer training in gsLearn. When ready, click here to request to open your bank account.

Take Intro to Girl Scouts. Log in to gsLearn to continue this next training in your New Leader Learning path .
