IT'S TIME! Troop Financial Reports are due.

The Annual Financial Tracking is due on **June 1, 2022**. It covers the period from May 1, 2021-April 30, 2022. The Tracking will complete the report, and the Tracking is due on **June 1, 2022**.

The Treasurer will complete the report, and the Troop Leader will submit it through the Volunteer Toolkit.

Here are some tips for Troop Leaders and Treasurers. Doing these things will help make the process of completing their report easier when the time comes.

- Make sure that your Troop Treasurer (and all bank account signers) have completed the Troop Treasurer Learning Path on gsLearn.
- Log in to your account at https://mygs.girlscouts.org, click on "My Account", click on gsLearn, click on Content Library, and access the Troop Treasurer Learning Path.
- Download the troop's monthly Wells Fargo bank statements from May 1, 2021-current.
- Review each bank statement. Make a note for each transaction.
- Gather all receipts for troop-related expenses in one place. Make sure to get receipts from anyone that makes purchases on behalf of the troop.
- A laptop or a personal computer (Not a Mac) is needed to load the report. Google Chrome or Firefox browsers are highly recommended.

Not sure where to start? What forms are needed? Check out the forms on the GSSD website. Forms | Girl Scouts San Diego (sdgirlscouts.org) There are forms for Troop Finances. Under Annual Financial Report for Troop Leaders there is a How to Guide. AD-0433W-How-To-Annual-Financial-Report.pdf (sdgirlscouts.org)

The <u>Troop Financial Tracking Worksheet</u> (available on GSSD website in forms) is used to help your Troop Treasurer keep track of troop funds. This is the best way to get the information that is needed to complete the Annual Financial Report.

Training For Registered Volunteers

Mandated Reporter Training

California Law AB506 NOW requires all staff & regular volunteers of youth serving organizations complete child abuse prevention training & fingerprint-based background screening (LiveScan). Troop Leaders, Co-Leaders and regular adult volunteers who will have direct contact or supervise a group of children for more than 16 hours per month or 32 hours per year will need this training and screening.

Right now only the Mandated Reporting Training is available through GSSD. We are waiting for GSSD quidance on how to complete the LiveScan.

Many of you have completed the training already and we appreciate it. If this training has been completed already as a requirement for a job or another volunteer role, then the training has been completed. Please be sure to upload your training certificate through gsLearn. For more information on how to upload a training certificate, please contact GSSD Customer Care at customercare@sdgirlscouts.org.

If anyone still needs to complete the training, it is available through gsLearn. Training is about 2 hours long and can be taken over time (training can be paused and completed later, you'll just need to log

back in to complete it.)

Here are the steps:

- 1. Login to MyGS/VTK
- 2. Go to gsLearn
- 3. Then go to Content Library
- 4. Search for 623 Mandated Reporter
