
Ready for the New Girl Scout Year?

Here are a couple of tips to get ready for the new membership year.

- Be sure to have all your troop and adult volunteers registered before 9/30/22.
- Check to see if you have your volunteers positions filled such as Troop Leader, Troop Assistant Leader, Troop Treasurer, Troop Cookie Manager and Fall Products Manager.
- If you'll be adding new girls to your troop be sure to submit a Troop Catalog Request Form found on GSSD website to let them know you are expecting new members. If you prefer to invite new members individually, go to MyGS and in "My Troop(s)" there is option to send an email to invite new members.

New for Girl Scouts - Summer 2022

Here is a brief list from the New Program Rollout 2022. To view the video, visit gsLearn, search the Library Content for GSUSSA 2022 New and Updated Program.

Daisy Petals and Handbook: The Petals content and Handbook are now designed to help the Daisy, parents, and volunteers through their first two years of Girl Scouting. Please note, the petal badge design hasn't changed.

Brownies: Brownie Pet Badges has been redesigned to include new and modern content to the earning the badge. Please note the design for the badge hasn't changed.

Financial Literacy Badges: This includes Badges for Daisies Through Ambassadors, 13 badges in total. The new content for each level has been designed to be age-appropriate and hands on for Girl Scouts at each level. What is new to the content is that it "provides the opportunity to think about Financial Literacy from an Outdoor, STEM, Life Skills, Entrepreneurial, and Global lens."

The final STEM Career Exploration Badges for Daisy, Senior and Ambassador levels will now be available. This completes the new badge line that started in 2020.

The 2023 World Thinking Day Award is "Our World, Our Peaceful Future: The Environment, Peace and Security".

The 2023 Global Action Award is themed around one of the UN's Sustainable Development Goals: Responsible Consumption and Production.





LIVESCAN info from Council

California Law AB506 now requires all staff & regular volunteers of youth serving organizations complete child abuse prevention training & fingerprint-based background screening (LiveScan).

Troop Leaders, Co-Leaders and regular adult volunteers who will have direct contact or supervise a group of children for more than 16 hours per month or 32 hours per year will need this training and screening.
